Here is your list of Business Associate Agreements (BAA's) needed.

This is just a sample. You may have more.

**All Dental Labs you use

**Any non-employee that are left alone and able to access charts:

IT techs Contractors Service Techs Equipment Techs Shredding Company Answering Services Housekeeping

**Any non-employees who access records:

Manufacturing Techs - Implants, etc that are there to help you.
Collections Agencies
Billing Services
Attorneys
OSHA Consultant
Practice Management Companies
3rd Party Insurance Companies
Off-site Backup Companies
Computer Program Company - ie: Softdent, Dentrix, etc.

**All Dental Labs you use

REMEMBER - Anyone who has access to records need to sign. However, if they do not have access, they do not need to sign a BAA. If you have ALL charts locked up - then Housekeepers would not sign. Have a chart here or there out - they have to sign. What about EOB's? Patient's new or Updated forms? Patients Charts in an unlocked storage closet?

Most large companies have BAA's signed and posted on their website for you to download.

Watch where the delivery men are coming in and dropping off at. If they come in the side door, but the room they enter has charts laying around, then you must move charts or have them enter another way. IE - Postman, UPS, FedEx, etc. These companies will not sign a BAA.
